No talking or singing along with the contestants


This is a fragrance free and smoke free convention. Please refrain from wearing perfume, scented lotion, or or similar products inside contest areas.

Unless authorized by the Administrative Panel Chair, no one is to enter the judging area during the contest, including intermissions.





#### Session 1-9:00 AM to 10:00 AM

## Class 1: Listening vs Hearing, Watching vs Believing - It's All About Performance! with Angie Dolber (Certified Performance Judge)

Location: Bushnells Basin

In this class we'll talk about the basics of the Performance Category and how the other two categories can enhance the performance experience as well. By looking at various performances, and even trying a little ourselves, we'll talk about words like artistry, authenticity, and how you can truly entertain the audience.

This class will examine ruts and how we can free ourselves from them so we can create new paths.
